Do-It-Yourself Bible Study

For our Bible study this month, let's look at Bible verses for Sunday, August 7th. If you find this intriguing I hope that you will join others to go deeper.

Jesus says, "It is your Father's good pleasure to give you the kingdom." It is God's promise from the beginning—to Abraham, to the early church, and to the little flock of which we are a part in todays assembly. Faith, God's baptismal gift, trust the promises of God. Have no fear.

Read Genesis 15:1-6. God promises childless and aging Abraham that a child of his own will be his heir and that his descendants will number as many as the stars. He trusts God's promise, and through this faith he is considered righteous. How do suppose Abraham felt after hearing this?

Abraham and Sarah exemplify the vison of faith that people of God enact in every age. Their hope and trust in God's promise allowed them to face an unknown future and to receive the promise of God.

Read Hebrews 11:1-3, 8-16. Faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen. Indeed by faith our ancestors received approval. By faith we understand that the worlds were prepared by the word of God. Do you think today's people have such faith?

Jesus encourages disciples to invest their hearts and live fully into God's reign. Instead of facing life with fear, those who know God's generosity are always ready to receive from God and to give to others.

Read Luke 12:32-40. Do not be afraid, little flock, for it is your Father's good pleasure to give you the kingdom. Sell your possessions, and give alms. This statement is surely all about faith too. Do we have such faith to sell everything we own to help others?

West Freeborn Lutheran Church Special Informational Meeting – July 17, 2022

The West Freeborn Church met on July 17, 2022, before church to discuss a few items.

- **Cemetery Stones:** Steve reported that Star Granite had been out and found 17 stones that needed repair. They will be coming back in August sometime to start work on these stones. Many of these stones are from the late 1800's or early 1900's with not any family still around. This is the first of a few items that donations would be needed for.
- **Social Hall Windows:** There are 8 windows in the Social Hall that need to be replaced. There are some bids that have been submitted ranging from \$12,177 \$14,500. These are vinyl windows which would need no maintenance. It would take 16 weeks to get these windows in. They are made in Minnesota. This is item number two that donations are needed for.
- **Sanctuary Walls:** Ohnstad has given a bid of \$25,000 and a 4 week time frame to do the walls on the inside of the sanctuary. We also have a Ben Erdner Dry Wall from Wells that would put up a ¼" piece of plywood and then drywall over it and paint. It was brought up that we need to find the root cause of why the walls are peeling. Is it the tuck pointing that is letting moisture in or an eaves trough that is not connected right? And finally, item number 3 on the donation list.

No matter which options we go with on the above issues, we will need money to do these matters. Do you think we should have some type of a fund-raiser or just make an appeal to the congregation to see if we can dig a little deeper into our pockets? I know with the way the world is right now, times are tough and your dollar doesn't stretch as far as it once did!!! 😳 😳 Let any council member know what you think.
