Pastor's Report: Pastor Marcia presented a detailed report to the council for the month of March. Five students will be confirmed on April 21. Pastor Marcia thanked the multitude of people that participated in one way or another during the Lenten season, Holy Week and Easter Sunday. Old Business: Building project updates include the following: After April 21, Jim and Dude's Plumbing Heating and Air Conditioning will be contacted to evacuate the gas for the air conditioners in social hall. Jill reported that the meal plans and work group for serving the Confirmation meal is coming together and gifts for the confirmands from the Cross of Glory congregation have also been purchased. Synod Assembly will be held on Saturday, May 11 at Mayo Clinic Health Systems Civic Center in Mankato. Delegates will be Ronnie Bartness and Mark Langrud. Pastor Marcia is exploring a format for Wednesday Worship. It is possible that May will host the first Wednesday Worship service. We will be transitioning to holding weekly worship services at 9:00 am beginning the first Sunday in June. This will continue for the coming year. Sunday, June 9 will be New Member Sunday. Coffee and rolls will be served following the service. The council accepted the resignation of Sunday School Superintendent, Lacey Koopal. We thank her for the many years of service in this leadership role. Spring cleanup of the church lawn will be April 13 at 9:00 am. A motion for adjournment was made by Martin and seconded by Steve.
