A Eucharistic Church

As the Transition team has been going about its work of anticipating the future, the matter of the joint parish of Cross of Glory and West Freeborn becoming Eucharistic has arisen.

Actually, I brought it up, and the Team discussed it. A Eucharistic Church celebrates the Lord's Supper every Sunday. So the Team is facilitating congregational discussion of this issue at Wednesday suppers. If the Team becomes convinced that a significant majority of the congregation would entertain this notion positively they could well include in its final report a recommendation of weekly communion to the joint church council. The council would then either accept or reject the recommendation, based on their sense of the fitness of things.

I have known interim pastors who have simply mandated weekly communion, that is, without consultation or permission have exercised the pastoral right to lead the congregation in things spiritual. I, however, think it would be a good thing if the parish as a whole thought about the matter and came to its own conclusion.

Here are a few pros and cons that come to mind. I start with the cons:

* "We have never done it that way." While some wags have called this sentence the "Seven Last Words of the Church," I do think there is something to be said for maintaining the status quo. Monthly communion is fine. Many Lutheran churches have historically adopted this rhythm. Religion likes regularity. We come to church not to be surprised by human changes but by God's grace.

* It would mean more work for the altar guild, requiring someone--some women--to prepare the elements weekly instead of monthly.

* It would regularly shorten the sermon time by 5 or 10 minutes.

Some points to consider in favor of weekly communion:

* Those members who find they must work some Sundays would always receive the Eucharist whenever they are able to come to church.

* It is healthy. Luther wrote in the Large Catechism: "The Lord's Supper nourishes the soul, and where the soul is nourished, there the body is also benefitted."

* Those who have gone Eucharistic often come to feel something is missing when they attend a Sunday service and there is not communion. One of my liturgical mentors somewhat facetiously called this a "dry mass."

* There is nothing wrong with it; in fact, it is catching on in many Lutheran parishes.

* It is one way to grow roots in the Lord. And if roots grow on a tree, leaves increase. In practical terms, I see the weekly celebration of communion as leading toward increased Sunday worship and even new members.

You can probably tell where I stand on this issue.
