



### **Christmas Greetings featuring...YOU!**

President Jerry Morstad called the meeting to order, and Pastor Marcia led us in a prayer. Carol read the minutes of the October 3, 2023 meeting. Matt made the motion to accept the Secretary's report and Ron seconded it. Motion carried. Linda gave the Treasurer's report. Jill made the motion to approve Treasurer's report as read and pay bills as funds allow. Ron seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Pastor's Report: Pastor Marcia presented a detailed report to the council for the month of October. If you would like to see the report, there will be one in the office to view. Confirmation Sunday went well; thanks to the many who made it go smoothly. Pastor Marcia gave a recap of the October events and services in her report.

Christmas Eve service at West Freeborn will be held at 9:00 am on December 24 and at 4:30 pm at Cross of Glory. There will not be a Christmas Day service at either church. Pastor Marcia is considering a social media event for Christmas Day. There has not been an update from the MSP/LIS service for rural communities.

New Business: A budget review meeting will be held at 9:15 on November 26. Officers and council members are invited to attend. At the present time there is no change in the slate of officers for the 2024 church year. There will be a potluck meal to be served before the annual meeting. Our Advent Mission Project will coincide with the Advent event on December 3. Monies from the free will offering will go towards area food shelves and the formation of the Cross of Glory Good Samaritan Fund. Emily reported that the water coming out of the drinking faucet in the kitchen has a very strong odor. There was a brainstorming session on how to improve this problem. Alvin will be contacted to see if the water softener can start to circulate the water in the pipes.
