Pastor Mark led the councils in devotion and prayer. The secretary's report from the last joint council meeting was read by Becky Ausen. Matt Hoelscher made a motion to approve the minutes as read. Randy Light seconded.

Pastor Mark gave his pastor's report. The cupboards in the parsonage are close to being finished. He also wants to make sure everyone knows he is very willing to do home visits for active congregation

members, congregation members who no longer attend church but are in need of pastoral support, or anyone who is interested in our church. He has provided his cell phone number 651-925-6509, and encourages people to call or text him. Dave Pederson had set up a website for the church but no one knows the address, nor has access to frequently update the home page, as is recommended to bring more interest to a website. Pastor Frank had mentioned that someone in the SEMN synod can help, so Cathy Crowe is going to investigate that contact.

There was a bill from Jensprint and one from One Write that the treasurers had some questions about and needed some clarification.

Regarding the Transition team, we will have to have some names for committee members by next council meeting so they can begin their work after the holidays. Pastor Mark has been asked to provide more information about the committee during church.

Next Sunday is the West Freeborn polka service so we will be switching service times. The Cross of Glory Sunday School Christmas program has been set for Dec. 14th as it would be easier to rehearse before the performance, they have requested we switch worship times then too. Becky Ausen made a motion to have West Freeborn's worship service at 9:00 a.m. and Cross of Glory's at 10:30 a.m. on Dec. 14 to accommodate the Sunday School program. Paul Lynne seconded.

Dave Ausen made a motion to adjourn this half of the meeting and to proceed with the individual councils' meetings. Randy Light seconded.

Cross of Glory Trustees and Deacons Meeting – November 11, 2014

- 2. When the locksmiths came to look at the safe, they discovered that the lock is very old and worn. Instead of transitioning to a new electronic access panel, they will remove one of the wheels that was causing the problems and see if it is easier to unlock.
- 3. None of the people we had discussed for approaching for the transition team has been willing to join. We will make sure to have the information put in the bulletin and announced in church to see who will express interest in helping to move our church forward with this committee.

New Business:

- 1. We discussed the Annual Meeting. Normally it is held the second Sunday of December but that is the day the Sunday School has chosen to have their program. With the month starting on a Monday, it reduces the number of Sundays before Christmas, which limits our choices for the Annual Meeting, as the first Sunday is a little too soon after the end of the budgetary year for the treasurer to be able to submit reports for publication. Thus Jon Stelter made a motion to hold the Annual Meeting on Dec. 21, following our normal 9:00 a.m. service and a potluck brunch. Paul Lynne seconded.  seconded.
- 3. It was suggested that we have Cindi make a copy of the church constitution and bylaws for the council members, as we look at possibly changing the structure of the trustees and deacons.

Paul Lynne made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Cathy Crowe seconded. Closed with the Lord's Prayer.
