<u>HEALING</u>

The joint council has approved the recommendation of the Transition Task Force that Cross and West explore the implications of the healing ministry.

I have responded to this affirmation by referring to the healing aspect of the gospel in my sermons and will continue to do so, sometimes devoting the entire sermon to the subject, sometimes referring to healing in only part of my homily.

With the assent of the members attending our staff meetings (my regular sounding board for church activities), for the present, we will be offering a special service of healing on the third Sunday of the month.

The new ELCA hymnal, called "Evangelical Lutheran Worship" or abbreviated, the "ELW" sometimes referred to as the "Cranberry Hymnal" for an obvious reason, contains a short service of healing. When the service is at Cross, we will use the hymnal, when it is at West, we will provide copies of the service as bulletin inserts.

We are not alone. At a recent text study attended by the pastors of the area and held weekly at a church in Albert Lea, I learned that Grace Lutheran holds a healing service on the fifth Sunday of the month and it is packed with many coming forward for anointing.

Another pastor reported that he scheduled his first healing service 15 minutes before the regular service time. So many showed up that the regular service had to be delayed for a half hour to respond to all those who came forward for healing. "And," he added, "They all stayed for the entire service."

I'm glad the emphasis on healing is coming back. The case for healing is so clear and simple one is surprised that it got put on the back burner for so long: Jesus healed, Jesus told his disciples to heal, Jesus gave us instruction as to how to go about it in James 5.

This command is nowhere repealed in Scripture. Please feel free to comment on how we are going about exploring the healing ministry as we proceed. Anyone is welcome to come to our regularly-scheduled Monday morning, 9:00 a.m. staff meeting; an ideal place to make input.
