If we would join together, we would form a three-point parish. He plans to serve for about another four years before retirement. We discussed this idea a bit before deciding to think about it more but hold off on such a significant step at this moment.
- 2. Jerry Morstad talked with Duane Spooner about the leaking under the parsonage steps. There was some talk of tiling, but with the water coming from the ceiling rather than the floor, tiling probably wouldn't make much difference. We will try removing the planter on the steps as a first attempt to change the water direction.
- 3. Pastor Mark's back surgery will be September 13 in Rochester. He has asked Pastor Espe to cover his medical leave for worship services on Sept. 18 & 25 and Oct. 2, as well as any funerals that may happen in that time frame.

4. Depending upon Pastor Mark's recovery, confirmation is tentatively set to begin Oct. 5. Kendall Habana will be starting a year early in West Freeborn's class. Pat Erich made a motion to adjourn this half of the meeting to allow the councils to reconvene for our respective council meetings. Dave Ausen seconded.
